

## FORMULA FOR WORKING OUT OVER ALL MERIT

- SSC/Matriculation/Equivalent Examination (10%)
- HSSC/F.Sc (Pre Medical) or Equivalent Examination. (40%) only science subjects marks shall be considered for calculating merit;
- MDCAT (50%)

### Example:

If a Candidate has obtained the following marks:

A	Matric Science/O Level Equivalent Examination	650 / 850 or 76.471 %
B	HSSC/A -Level Equivalent Examination	390 / 600 or 65.000 %
C	MDCAT Marks	137 / 210 or 65 %

His/her Merit will be calculated as follows:

A	Matric Science/O Level Equivalent Examination	76.471 %x0.1=7.647 %
B	HSSC/A-Level Equivalent Examination	65.000 %x0.4=26.000 %
C	Entry Test Marks	65.000 %x0.5=32.5 %

Over all Merit of the Candidate	A+B+C = 7.647 + 26.000 + 32.5 = 66.147 %
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All calculation in percentages will be rounded up to five decimal points. In case final merit of more than one candidate is equal up to five decimals, the candidate older in age shall stand higher in merit.

Following Marks shall be added in the total marks of the candidate in his / her HSSC ( Pre- Medical ) qualifying examination in order to adjust the marks.

Twenty (20) marks will be added to all Hafiz-e-Quran candidates subject to the clearance of Hafiz-e-Quran Interview, to be conducted by Hafiz-e-Quran Committee and production of legitimate certificate from an approved institution that he/she is a Hafiz-e-Quran. Interview committee for Hafiz-e-Quran candidates will be constituted by the concerned vice chancellor to conduct interview of Hafiz-e-Quran candidates to ensure that he / she is a genuine Hafiz-e- Quran.
