Admission Criteria

- ▶ 16 years of education
- ▶ Academic Record
- Performance in the Admission Test
- Work Experience
- ▶ Two Letters of Recommendation
- Completed and submitted application form and supporting documents by the stipulated deadline

This is the minimum eligibility criteria that applicants need to fulfill in order to be eligible to apply.
